Update: September 20, 2008

Hello Neighbors,

Unfortunately we experienced a break-in this past Thursday, September 18th on Royal Bluff at appx. 9:30 AM. An observant resident witnessed a suspicious person and contacted the DeKalb Police (via 911) and Neighborhood Watch street captains, who relayed the information to the home owner almost immediately. Although the perpetrator was not caught, the police and home owners were able to respond quickly to the situation. Ashwood Neighborhood Watch will work with the DeKalb Police Department and our designated contact during the ongoing investigation of this crime.

We recently re-activated our Neighborhood Watch program and many residents were able to meet with DeKalb Police personnel at the Annual Ashwood BBQ on Sept. 14th. At that time, they distributed literature to residents and answered questions.
